

**EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE COUNTY BOARD  
JUNE 21, 2010**

The Board of Commissioners of Freeborn County met in Emergency Session in the Freeborn County Boardroom at 5:15 p.m., on Monday June 21, 2010. Members present: Commissioners, Shoff, Belshan, Tuttle, Nelson and Mathiason.

Commissioner Mathiason offered the following resolution

**RESOLUTION 10 – 139  
RESOLUTION DECLARING A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS** the June 17, 2010 storm event impacted the population of Freeborn County and its cities; and

**WHEREAS** the June 17, 2010 storm event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

**WHEREAS** the Freeborn County Department of Emergency Management requests the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners to declare a LOCAL EMERGENCY for Freeborn County; for the June 17, 2010 storm event.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners declares a Local Emergency for Freeborn County in response to the conditions resulting from the June 17, 2010 storm event.

Resolution seconded by Commissioner Nelson.

After discussion, a vote was taken and the Chair declared the resolution unanimously adopted

Commissioner Belshan offered the following resolution.

**RESOLUTION 10 – 140  
RESOLUTION REQUESTING REASSESSMENT OF DAMAGED PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS** the June 17, 2010 storm event impacted the residents of Freeborn County; and

**WHEREAS** the June 17, 2010 storm event has caused a significant amount of property damage to the residents of Freeborn County; and

**WHEREAS** the Freeborn County Assessor has asked the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners to consider a resolution requesting reassessment of damaged property due to the June 17, 2010 storm event.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners adopt a resolution requesting reassessment of damaged property for the purpose of the relief provided under Minnesota Statue 273.1231 to 273.1235 due to the June 17, 2010 storm event.

Resolution seconded by Commissioner Tuttle.

After discussion a vote was taken and the Chair declared the resolution unanimously adopted.

Discussion was held on the high water level of Shell Rock River in the southern portions of Freeborn County. The County Administrator will communicate with the County Ditch Inspector and the Shell Rock River Watershed District regarding this concern.

Commissioner Shoff adjourned the Emergency Meeting of the County Board at 5:47 p.m.
