

**ADJOURNED EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE COUNTY BOARD**  
**July 12, 2022**

The Board of Commissioners of Freeborn County met in the Freeborn Room of the Freeborn County Courthouse at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, July 12, 2022. Members present: Commissioners Belshan, Edwin, and Forman. Commissioner Herman was excused. Commissioner Shoff attempted to appear via zoom, however there were audio difficulties and the Chairman was unable to participate in discussion and roll call.

With the Chairman and Vice Chairman not present, Commissioner Forman called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Edwin offered the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION No. 22-213**  
**Local Declaration of a State of Emergency**

WHEREAS, severe weather/flood event has impacted the population of Freeborn County and its cities on July 5, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this severe weather/flood event has caused a significant amount of public property damage as well as necessary infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Freeborn County Department of Emergency Management requests the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners to declare Freeborn County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY due to the severe weather/flood event;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Freeborn County Board of Commissioners declare that a state of emergency exists with Freeborn County for conditions resulting from this storm event, with all powers and responsibilities attending thereto as provided by Minnesota Statute Chapter 12.29.

Resolution was seconded by Commissioner Belshan.

After discussion, a vote was taken and Commissioner Forman declared the resolution adopted.

Commissioner Belshan offered the following motion;

**MOVED**, to adjourn the Emergency Meeting.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Edwin.

After discussion, a vote was taken and Commissioner Forman adjourned the emergency meeting at 8:37 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday July 19, 2022.
