Recycling is easy with Single Sort!

Place the following items together in your cart:

- Clean glass bottles and jars
- Metal cans and empty aerosol containers
- Mixed Plastics Recycling - plastic bottles, containers, lids and tubs (#1-7) **no foam, film or plastic bags**
- Paper - news, office, junk mail, magazines, paper food boxes, cardboard, books, and clean pizza boxes
- Pop and beer cartons

Roll cart to the end of your driveway every other week on your service day by 7:00am.

Face the lid opening toward the street and handle toward the house.

Large cardboard boxes can be flattened, tied into bundles no more than three feet long by three feet wide by one foot tall and then placed next to your Single Sort cart.

Your service day can be found easily from our website map.

DO NOT INCLUDE: food waste, films, plastic bags, plastic wrap, or foam cups and containers.
