



RADON Test your Home

Radon is naturally occurring gas that enters buildings from the surrounding soil. It is colorless, odorless, tasteless and radioactive. The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) estimates that one in three Minnesota homes have enough radon to pose a significant health risk to occupants' with long term exposures. Radon is known to be the second leading cause of lung cancer.

Testing is the only way to find out how much radon is in your home. The Environmental Protection Agency and MDH recommend that all homes be tested for radon. Test kits can be purchased by using the order form below.
