

CSAH 26 Culvert Replacement in City of Hayward – A project to replace an existing box culvert located on CSAH 26 in the City of Hayward started on Thursday, September 19. The road will be closed to traffic during the project. The new box culvert installation is nearly complete. The crew is working to finish the end treatments, riprap, and miscellaneous culverts and tile around the new structure. The new target date for opening the roadway to traffic is Monday, September 30 at the end of the work day. There is a signed detour route that uses County Roads 46, 30, and 19.

CSAH 26 Culvert Replacement 0.7 miles north of CSAH 13 – This project will also involve the replacement of a box culvert. The project will commence after the completion of the project in Hayward. The expected road closure date is Tuesday, October 1. The project is expected to take two weeks. There will be a signed detour for this project that will use County Roads 19, 30, and 13.

CSAH 17 Culvert Replacement near west County Line – This project will involve the replacement of a steel culvert with a new concrete arch pipe. This is planned to be the last of the three culvert projects and has an approximate projected start date of October 14. Please check back for updates on the status of this project. The detour route will use County Roads 4 and 46 and also Faribault County Roads 16 and 30. This project is expected to take two weeks to complete.
